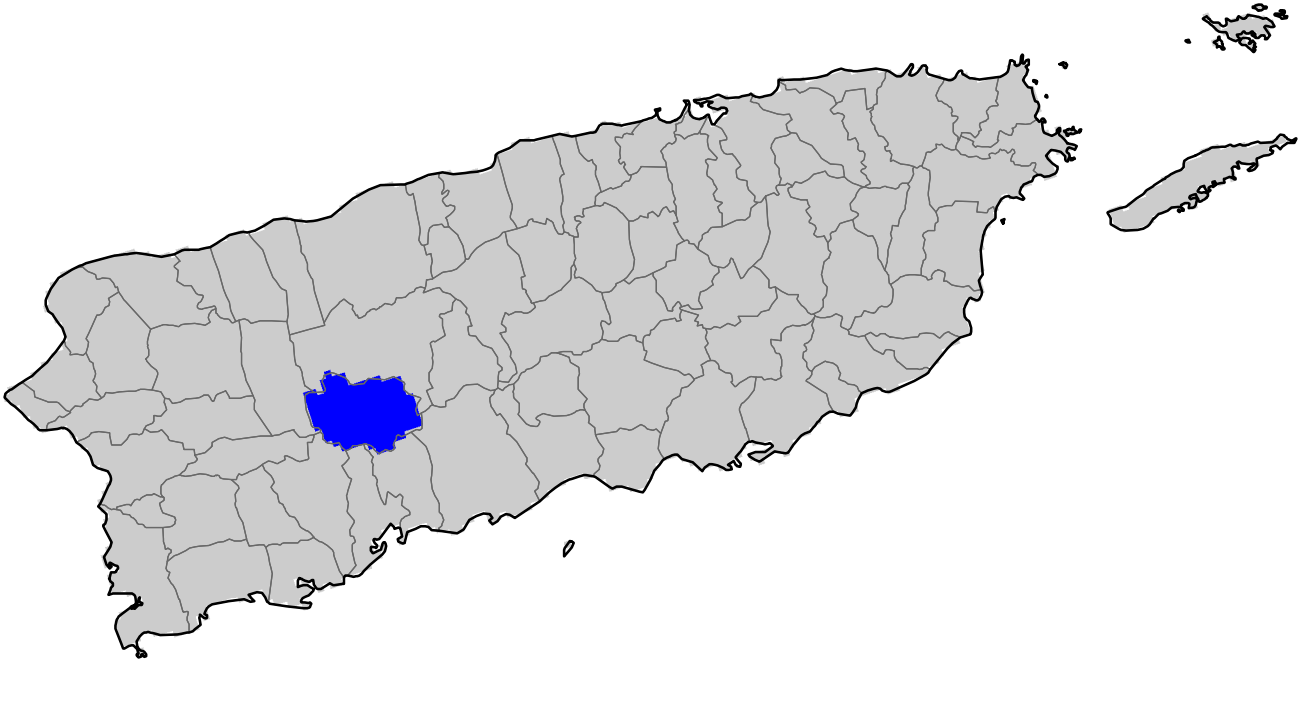


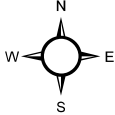
# Commodity Acreage Map

## Citron, *Citrus medica*

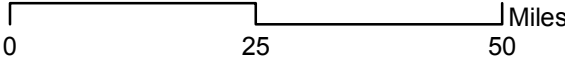
